Petitioner: Due to the raised entrance on the property, a commercial use of the space would not be ADA compliant and I wanted to convert the bottom use to a residential use.

Elijah: We are still determining whether or not this would considered a use variance and if so the ZBA cannot grant them.

On a motion made by Todd Taylor and seconded by Henry Wilson, it was voted unanimously (6-0-0) to recommend that the Zoning Board of Appeals approve the Special Permit for the use with the standard conditions pending the legality of the case.
